DRESSAGE

Lessons are held privately (45 min), generally in the outdoor arena.



XC TECHNIQUE

These lessons are not on a XC course, but either in the outdoor arena or in a grass paddock.



SHOW JUMPING

Lessons can be held in groups (3 pp max) or privately, generally in the indoor arena

Train XC safely using a combination of SJ poles, barrels, brushes and liverpools. Train XC style fences (ie. apex's, skinnies, angles. etc.) and improve your technique on lines and combinations.

Note: back protectors required
